Itinerary

Fri 8th Jan - Cape Town / Hazyview

Check out of your Cape Town hotel and transfer to the airport for your flight to Johannesburg. On arrival at Johannesburg, join your coach transfer to Hazyview and the Casa Do Sol Hotel, where you will stay for two nights' accommodation on a dinner, bed and breakfast basis. There's so much to see and do and the hotel is uniquely situated within the 500 hectare "Ilanga nature and game reserve" with over 100 different species of indigenous bush and breeding herds of non-aggressive game. There are on-site hiking and mountain biking trails, tennis courts and swimming pools as well as a number of water activities including fishing, and boating on the resort's private dam. If you need a bit of time out to restore your energy, then sit back, relax, and enjoy the scenery and dramatic landscapes of Mpumalanga, before dinner at the hotel.




Sat 9th Jan - Hazyview



After breakfast, depart with private coach to the rolling hills and spectacular rock formations of the rugged Northern Drakensberg Mountain Range that touch the sky, and form a dramatic backdrop to the third largest canyon of its kind in the world, the Blyde River Canyon. Cascading waterfalls plummet dramatically into the gorge as we view the Lowveld from God's Window. We visit the picturesque village of Graskop and the quaint town of Pilgrims

Rest to find out all about the gold rush in this historical mining town. All the beauty of the area will increase your appetite, so lunch is at the famous Harrie's Pancakes (customer's own account). After lunch we continue our tour to Bourke's Luck Potholes to marvel at another incredible creation of nature as we witness the power of water against solid rock! On the return journey to the hotel, you will have time to see it all from the other side and you will reflect once again on the marvels of nature you experienced all in one day! Enjoy dinner at the hotel.



Sun 10th Jan - Hazyview / Kruger Park

Enjoy breakfast at your hotel and check out. We have an early start and hit the road to Kruger National Park for an unforgettable experience at the Protea Hotel Kruger Gate for two nights' accommodation on a dinner, bed and breakfast basis. After lunch (own account) and some time to unpack, head off on a guided game drive in open Land Rovers - to find your first animals and a opportunity to spot the 'Big Five' and take in the pristine wilderness of the national park. Return back to the hotel in time for dinner.

Mon 11th Jan - Kruger Park

After breakfast, depart in open Land Rovers on a full day game viewing. Tonight enjoy a boma dinner and relax around the fire whilst listening to the night sounds of Africa.

Tues 12th Jan - Kruger Park / Johannesburg

After breakfast (or an optional game drive), check out of your accommodation and join your coach transfer to Sandton, Johannesburg.

Wed 13th Jan - Johannesburg

Rejoin your main tour itinerary.
